



Volunteer Opportunity

Ningaloo Marine Park, Western Australia

Position Title:	Ningaloo Turtle Program (NTP) Volunteer
Duration:	5 weeks (10 th December 2017 -14 th January 2018) – non-negotiable
Hours:	Approximately 35 hours/week (generally 5:30am start) irregular hours including weekends.
Location:	Ningaloo Marine Park (North-West Cape), Cape Range National Park and Exmouth, Western Australia.
Accommodation Location:	Two types of accommodation are provided. On a rotational basis you will stay at the remote camp within Cape Range National Park and the remainder of your time will be spent in shared accommodation in the town of Exmouth.
Cost:	\$1300 (inc \$500 non-refundable deposit required upon acceptance) covers your accommodation costs. Food is not provided. Transport is provided to official NTP activities only. Travel between your home and Exmouth is at your own expense.
Major responsibilities:	Turtle track monitoring and data entry
Requirements	All participants must be physically able to walk on sand for up to 6km in hot conditions. Applicants must be at least 18 years of age, present fit for work whilst on duty and act in accordance with the Department of Parks and Wildlife’s Code of Conduct. International volunteers must have travel insurance which covers them for any personal medical costs throughout the duration of the program. A full manual driver’s license and Senior First Aid qualification are desirable.
